

## Target Behaviors

- Keep your hands to yourself
- Using kind and positive words
- Participates in class
- Asking and answering questions
- Keep on listening ears
- Follow and listen to directions the first time


## Tokens

- For each behavior, the student exhibits they will receive a different color strip of paper
- Keeping your hands to yourself=1 blue strip
- Using kind and positive words=2 green strips
- Participating in class=every time they participate is 1 yellow strip
- Keep on listening ears=2 orange strips


## Reinforcers

- Students can exchange their chain at lunch or at the end of the day
- After 5 of one color the student can exchange their chain in for a small prize
- The student will rip off the 5 strips making the chain shorter
- Save the chain until it reaches the ground for a bigger prize


## Prizes

- Small Prizes=5 of one color from the chain
- School Pencil
- 10 extra minutes of recess
- Ice-cream at lunch
- Big Prizes=saving up until the chain hits the ground
- Lunch with the teacher
- Student and a friend will get to each lunch with Miss Padula
- Be line leader for a week
- Be the teacher for morning meeting
- Student will get to be the teacher for Miss Padula's morning meeting
- School announcements
- Student will get to go on the loudspeaker to say morning announcements for the school


## Fading Out

- If the student is receiving 2 chains as a reward for their behavior it will be lowered to 1 chain
- Once the students has mastered one behavior the teacher will take that behavior out of the reward system until there is no more behaviors to work on


## Using the tokens and storage

- Using
- Each teacher the student has will know the reward system
- The teacher will tell the students after class what color they can put on their chain if they earned one
- Storage
- The chain will be in the back of the student's homeroom
- There will be a bin of precut strips for the students to take out when they are told
